

Hard Floor Easy 5 Step Product Guide

→ Prostrip



Step 1: Strip

Can be applied with mop or rotary scrubbing machine.

Ammonia free floor polish stripper and cleaner for the removal of old metallised emulsion polish.

Dark blue liquid with mild odour.

→ Prorinse



Step 2: Neutralise

Acidic rinsing agent for neutralising alkaline floor polish stripper before applying new emulsion polish.

Prevents reaction and powdering of new polish.

Orange Liquid.

→ Proseal



Step 3: Seal

A water-based acrylic seal for vinyl, rubber, asphalt, terrazzo, linoleum and semi-porous floor surfaces.

Provides base-coat seal with satin finish which can be top-coated with Proshine if required.

White emulsion with acrylic odour.

→ Proshine



Step 4: Polish

Contains high solids polymer for a long-lasting deep slip resistant shine.

High gloss, metallised emulsion, self-shining polish for vinyl, thermoplastic and sealed floors.

Two or three thin coats are recommended for best results.

White emulsion with acrylic odour.

→ Protreat



Step 5: Maintain

Neutral pH polyethylene wax-based floor maintainer for damp mopping and spray buffing of vinyl, thermoplastic and stone floors.

Produces a rich buffable slip resistant shine on sealed floors.

Pink emulsion with floral fragrance.
